

FAQ – Listing a 2nd Email Address on a Form 1 Statement of Organization

In CrimsonFiler, an FEC Form 1 - Statement of Organization can list up to two email addresses under the **Committee's E-mail Address** section.


The first email address listed will appear as the Committee's primary e-mail Address and the subsequent email address that follows will be considered an optional e-mail address.

In order to report two email addresses on an FEC Form 1, you need to list the email address separated by a semi-colon (;) with no spaces on the **Main** tab of the report in CrimsonFiler and then press the blue


 button.
