

About column headers:

- **FIELD DESCRIPTION** demonstrates the field labels as they appear in CrimsonFiler.
- *(EXPORT FIELD DESCRIPTION)* indicates the column headers in a schedule export file.
- **REQUIRED FIELD** tells whether the field is required by the FEC for filing.
- *(RESULT)* tells whether this field will produce an error (or not validate the report), or will result in an FEC warning after validation.
