


Crimson allows you to automatically suppress flags for records you do not want to include in a list pull, such as **Thank You's**, **Best Efforts**, or **People Search** lists. Below are the steps to add suppression flags to your search criteria.

## Setting Up Channel Suppression Flags

1. From the main menu, go to **People > Settings > Flag**.
2. **Add** a new flag or click on the **Edit** button of the flag you want to have suppressed.
3. Check the box next to **“This is a Channel Suppression Flag”** and check at least one of the **Target Channels to be suppressed**. (For more information on this setting, see [Crimson: People Search - Advanced Export by Channel](#)).
4. **Save** your changes.



## Applying Channel Suppression Flags

Click on the toggle switch next to **“Apply Channel Suppression Flags”** in **People Search**, **Best Efforts** and **Thank You** searches. People Search will suppress records with those flags set up in its setting.
